



ENBRIDGE IN MINNESOTA: Clearbrook Terminal

Clearbrook Terminal is critical to the Enbridge liquids transportation system as it serves as a hub for our mainline pipelines coming in from western Canada and western North Dakota, delivering to connections that support 70 percent of Midwest refineries' needs.

Clearbrook Terminal has been located in Clearwater County, Minnesota for nearly seven decades. This terminal includes 9 above-ground crude oil breakout storage tanks.

Clearbrook Terminal serves as a control point and hub facility for crude oil products. We transport and temporarily store these products en route to their refining destination. This facility serves eight pipelines—six in-bound, four out-bound and two lines that pass through the Terminal.

The workforce at Clearbrook Terminal includes 17 full-time Enbridge employees. Jobs within the terminal include: Technicians (Mechanical and Electrical); Operations Staff; Administrative Assistant; Terminal Coordinator and Supervisor.

Safe and reliable operations are the foundation of Enbridge's business. All Enbridge pipeline systems are monitored 24-hours per day. As the operators of vital energy infrastructure across North America, we know that the public has entrusted us with the responsibility to deliver the energy we all need and use, safely and reliably.
