

# NOTICE OF A PROPOSAL AND NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING

## By Enbridge Inc. to Engage in a Renewable Energy Project

**Project Name:** Dawn Solar and Battery  
Energy Storage Project (the Project)

**Project Location:** The Project will be located on Enbridge-owned lands in the Township of Dawn-Euphemia in the County of Lambton, Ontario. The main Project footprint will be located on Bentpath Line, and the full Site Boundary to account for construction logistics is bordered by Cuthbert Road to the east, Bentpath Line to the south, Dawn Valley Road to the west, and a backlot line and the Dawn facility to the north. The Project Footprint will be located on land zoned Agricultural, and the Site Boundary will also include land zoned Industrial and Significant Woodlands (Township of Dawn-Euphemia, 2014).

**Dated at the Township of Dawn-Euphemia, the 19th day of December 2023**

Enbridge Inc. is planning to engage in a renewable energy project in respect of which the issuance of a renewable energy approval is required. The distribution of this Notice of a Proposal to engage in this renewable energy project and the Project itself are subject to the provisions of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) Part V.0.1 and the Ontario Regulation 359/09 (Regulation). This notice must be distributed in accordance with section 15 of the Regulation prior to an application being submitted and assessed for completeness by the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks.

A public meeting will be held to share information with members of the community and interested stakeholders. The meeting will be an open-house format and attendees may drop in anytime within the specified hours to view information about the Project, ask questions, and provide feedback.

### Project Description:

Pursuant to the Act and Regulation, the facility, in respect of which the Project is to be engaged in, is considered to be a Class 3 Solar Facility. If approved, this facility would have a total maximum name plate capacity of 1-2 MW for the Project's solar component and 1-2 MW for the Project's Battery Energy Store component. The Project location is described in the map above.

### Documents for Public Inspection:

The Project is being proposed in accordance with the requirements of the Act and Regulation. The Draft Project Description Report titled "Dawn Solar and BESS Project: Draft Project Description Report" describes the Project as a Class 3 Solar Facility with a Battery Energy Storage System which will include solar panels and racking, inverters and transformers, electrical interconnection, a substation and communications tower, access roads, buildings and structures, perimeter fencing, temporary storage and staging areas, battery cells and modules, battery racks, and battery and power systems.
